



CELBAN Preparation Crash Course (Weekdays)

When: October 17 to November 16, 2017 (30 hours for five weeks)

What Time: First and last week - Tuesdays to Thursdays
Second, third and fourth week - Mondays to Wednesdays
8:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. (Classroom Instruction)
10:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. (Self-directed Practice Time)

Cost: Only \$450 per person

Target Audience:

This course is designed to enhance participants' English Language competency in order to prepare them to practice their nursing career in Canada. The course will help IENs to improve their English language skills in four required areas: Listening / Speaking / Reading / Writing. This review program place great efforts on English language skill building and skill using. Besides classroom instruction, participants will spend an equal amount of time practice on their assignments guided by well trained volunteers. The course will also focus on enhancing test-takers' confidence and skills / strategies to write the test.

What does the course cover?

Besides covering CELBAN test preparations, the course also focuses on the improvement of time management, test-taking strategies, and hands-on experience in writing the test.

Outcome:

At the end of the course, participants will be well-equipped and trained in CELBAN preparation with sufficient knowledge, skills, and hands-on experience in test-taking.

Note: This course is delivered in partnership with E-Star Winnipeg. Success Skills Centre is closed for all statutory holidays. At least five participants will be needed to start the course.
